On Feb. 17th we received a mandate from you to renovate the current church building and to appoint a committee to prepare a plan for this project. The first step in fulfilling our mandate was to look for person(s) with the necessary skills to prepare and implement this plan. We are pleased to announce that **Mr. Steven Porter has agreed to head up All Saints Renovation Committee**, a sub-committee of vestry. He is well respected in the construction industry and will bring to this committee the skills necessary to ensure the success of this project.

The success of this project will also depend on your gifts of time, talent and treasure. We ask that you make your financial contributions by placing them in a plain envelope containing Church Renovations, your name / envelope number and amount enclosed. We ask that you step up to the plate and help out with the many functions taking place at All Saints: some will be specifically for renovations and others will be for the day to day operations.

The Protection of Health Information Act (PHIA) will be implemented in Newfoundland and Labrador in March 2011. This Act requires consent for the collection and distribution of all personal health information in hospitals and long-term care facilities. You will likely notice some changes in the questions asked when you are being registered or admitted for health care services. If you are admitted to the hospital and would like to be visited by the Anglican chaplain, please be sure to identify your religion when you are admitted or registered. The chaplains can pass on a message to your parish clergy if you specifically ask them to do so, or better still have someone in your family call your clergy or the church office. Only with your consent can notification of your hospitalization or other health information be shared with others, including your parish clergy.

Outreach:

In addition to our personal care home visits on Tuesday afternoons, we will be providing Sunday worship to Bayview Manor on the first Sunday of every month and to Admirals Coast on the second Sunday of every month.
