### Liturgical Planners

These are the people who plan the 10.00 Eucharist. There are about five teams consisting of four or five members. The team meets a week or so before the Sunday they have to plan. The planning takes one or two hours. The parish provides resources to assist the planners in the choices made to create the liturgy. The basic outline of the service comes from the BAS but it is enhanced and expanded according to the theme for the day and other considerations., such as the readings and the Church season. Liturgical planning requires a sense of what worship is about and it is helped by use of the imagination. Over time participants should learn how worship 'works' and grow in understanding and sensitivity.

If you would like to do this ministry, contact one of the clergy. It will give you another perspective on worship while providing new insights and knowledge. Teams have a vacancy from time to time. Some of the present planners have been involved for years which indicates the satisfaction and pleasure they derive. Thanks to past and present liturgical planners.
