Environmental Week 2011

June 5th to 11th is Environment Week in our province. As All Saints regards itself as a *Going Green* parish, we are encouraging all parishioners to join with the environmental stewardship campaign by doing your part to help clean, preserve, and beautify God's wondrous creation. Even just small contributions are important and form part of your commitment to being a responsible steward of God's property.

The *Stewardship Ministry Team* of All Saints invites

all parishioners to join with the town of CBS in their three hour clean-up challenge which is being held on June 4th. All Saints is a strong representative of this town and it is fitting that we participate in this event. We will also be promoting environmental stewardship at our worship on June 5th. Perhaps you can personalize this even more through examining ways that you can become a more environmentally friendly steward. The time to start taking environmental action is NOW.

What do YOU see in your environment?

I take an early morning walk nearly every day, lasting about 20 or 30 minutes, which takes me to various points in my neighbourhood. On this walk, I take a bag to collect litter left on streets and the shoulders of roads. In a 90 day period last year I picked up a 30 day average of 80 bottles, 60 cans, and 110 cups. The simplest solution to littering is not to do it in the first place. The

second solution is to pick it up on the frontage of your own property. A third solution is to adopt a street or part of one to keep clean. You can do this weekly or even monthly. All you need is a shopping bag and gloves. It would make a significant difference. If you are already doing this or plan to do so, you might keep a similar record for a thirty day period and forward the

It would be useful to see how much difference we can make.
