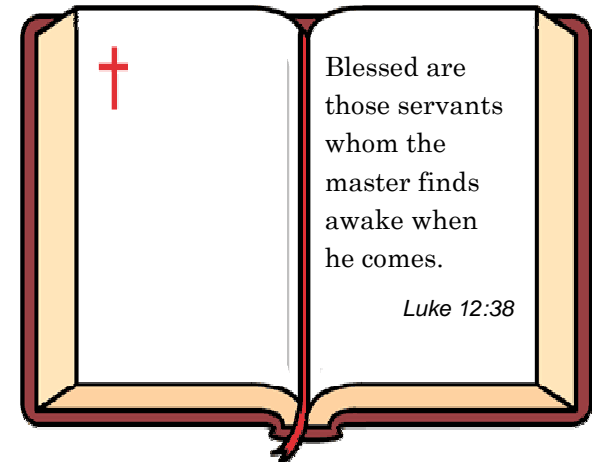

## Fifty Years

I was ordained Deacon in the Church of God on June 4, 1961 by Bishop John Meaden at the Cathedral of St John the Baptist, St John's. In the fifty years since I have served in the following parishes and positions: Parish of Foxtrap; Parish of St Mary's, Primrose Hill, London; Chaplain/Tutor at Queen's College, St John's; Parish of Trinity East - Port Rexton; Parish of St Augustine's, Queensgate, London; Parish of St Michael's, St John's; Chaplain to Hospitals and Institutions, St John's; Parish of Chance Cove, Little Harbour and Fair Haven; Parish of Heart's Content and Parish of All Saints, C.B.S.

During this period, while living in England, I also worked at the United Society for Propagation of the Gospel (USPG), the Society for the Promotion of Christian Knowledge (SPCK) and King's College Library. And I taught for two years in the state school system.

I did further study at King's College, University of London, and General Seminary, New York. In addition I took a nine month sabbatical, dividing my time between a program at Glens Falls, New York, and at a Benedictine Monastery in Mount Angel, Oregon.

I also had the privilege of attending General Synod and Provincial Synod, and serving at Regional Dean. During my years in health care ministry, I was involved with various committees and efforts promoting pastoral care in the Province.

I share this with you because few of you will have an overview of my fifty years of ministry. Over these years I have traveled with many companions. You have accepted me, and offered nourishment, encouragement and support, in effect, unconditional love. I thank you. The journey continues.
