### Phase-1 of our renovation project update:

To complete Phase 1 we need \$252,572.67

We have also received requests to transfer another \$14,042.56 from the Future Fund to the Renovation Fund.

### **All Saints Partners with Cartwright**

On Sept 23rd four representatives from our parish will begin their journey to Cartwright to begin an ongoing partnership with the Anglican Community there. Our team will spend Sunday and Monday in Port Hope Simpson where we will provide a prayer and praise service and host a workshop on a variety of Christian programs for the local church leaders. The team will arrive in Cartwright on Sept 27th to learn from the townspeople by listening and experiencing. In exchange we will provide worship, workshops, bible studies, VBS for the children and a Youth Camp for the teenagers. From Cartwright we will travel to Paradise River for a Service of Holy Eucharist.

We will be back in CBS on October 5th with many stories to share.

We are extremely grateful for the contributions we have received to date: they will assist us with the costs of travel and the resources for adult and youth ministries that we will be leaving with the Labrador teams. If you would like to make a donation to this mission, simply place it in a plain white envelope marked Labrador Mission.
