#### **Renovations:**

Work continues on Phase 1 of our church building, there have been some minor delays but we are pleased with the progress. To date the foundation and the rafters have been reinforced. Windows, siding and roofing will be completed by the end of October in time for our Festival which has been scheduled for November 5th and 6th.
