### **Confirmation:**

Confirmation is not a requirement but a choice. You choose to make a commitment of faith based on your experiences and knowledge about God. You decide to be an active member of the body of Christ: the Church. You become members at your baptism, at your Confirmation you take on the responsibilities that come with being a member: every thing you do is done in response to your relationship to Jesus Christ.

Your response might include becoming a Server, a Reader, a Sidesperson or a Greeter. You might choose to make contributions to the food bank by giving a little of your allowance, or you might give a helping hand to your neighbour. It always includes worship.

The requirements for confirmation classes are in place to help you make your choice. September, 2012 a new confirmation class will begin for participants of our Faith Café now. We meet the last Sunday night of every month from 7pm- 8pm. IF you intend on becoming a candidate for confirmation next year you must sign up for Faith Café now.

### **Renovation Project: Phase 1 is completed - Phase 2 begins !!**

Together we have accomplished a major task: the basement pillars have been reinforced; attic beams have been reinforced; new windows, siding, doors and roofing have been installed. All of this has come within our budget.

Phase 2 brings us to the interior where we will begin alterations and restoration. We will be adding insulation in the walls and ceiling, plumbing for a washroom, replacing electrical, interior sheathing, and flooring.

Phase 2 will be broken down into sub-phases to ensure minimal disruption of our weekly worship services. We can plan, but achievement depends on your willingness to support.

Your gifts of time, talent and treasure are vital to the successful and timely completion of Phase 2.

Its important to mention that in the midst of our renovation project, our day to day operating budget has not suffered; in fact our weekly offerings have increased. Bravo !!!
