### Financial Report

### General Fund

Our 2011 Parish day to day operating budget is \$349,000. As of the end of October we have contributed, through envelope offerings, loose collection and special donations, a total of \$199,428. We have raised an additional \$50,155 through special events including hall rentals. To date our income from all sources totals \$249,593 while our total expenses to date amounts to \$287,195.

### **Renovation Fund**

As of the end of October we have contributed through Offerings & Memorials \$136,193.00. We have transfers from Future Fund \$43,289.00. We have raised through monthly take-outs, Ladies Night Out, Sobeys Certificates and sale of old church windows \$13,058.00 for a total of \$192,540.00

Please consider whether or not you are doing all you can to support your church.

### **Preparation for Confirmation: A Two-Year Process**

Confirmation isn't a requirement – it is a choice. As a parish our goal is to provide our candidates with the foundational teachings they will need to confirm their faith at their Confirmation.

We currently have twelve candidates going through Step One: Faith Cafe, they will move to Step Two: in Sept and will be confirmed in Jan 2013.

Our forty-eight candidates completing Step two will be confirmed in January 2012.

ONLY THOSE WHO HAVE COMPLETED STEP ONE(FAITH CAFÉ)WILL ENTER STEP TWO IN SEPTEMBER AND BE CONFIRMED IN JANUARY 2013. New candidates entering the process in Sept, 2012 will begin with Step 1: Faith Café and they must be a minimum of 11 years of age by December 31st, 2012.

### **Marriage Course**

The clergy of the Deaneries of Avalon East and West have agreed that all couples planning to get married must complete a marriage course. We feel that as a Church we must provide an opportunity for adequate education in preparation for a Christian Marriage.

The Anglican Church of Canada's Canon 'On Marriage in the Church' states:

It shall...be the duty of the minister to provide or secure appropriate means of education so that all who seek marriage in the Church may come to it with a Christian understanding of its purpose and may be encouraged to give effect with God's help to the vows which they are preparing to make. CanonXII.1.2
