RENOVATION PROJECT

We are pleased to report that the total cost for Phase 1 came in slightly under our projected budget of \$252,572.67 and with the exception of the placement of our beautiful polished stainless steel cross, which will be installed over the main entrance within the coming days, our exterior renovation is complete.

In 10 months you contributed through envelope offerings, memorials, transfers and fundraising more than \$200,000. *(Our year end statement will show the exact amount of both income and expenses)*

The preliminary work for Phase 2 is now underway. This includes making application to the Diocese; gathering the information re costs and building codes; consulting with structural and architectural engineers.

Our plan is to complete phase 2 in three stages: 1. North wing, 2. South wing, 3. Main body including the narthex (porch), chancel / altar area. We anticipate beginning with the north wing where we will be installing foam insulation, new electrical, and a wheelchair accessible washroom.

We welcome your suggestions for the renovation, restoration and alterations of the interior of our church building.

The team will be making a presentation to you as soon as all pertinent information has been gathered. Start dates will depend on your continued support.
