Day to day operation:

Total expenses for 2011 — \$348,870 Total income for 2011 — \$347,859

While we have done everything we can to cut costs, we will need a total income of \$359,800 to balance our anticipated budget for 2012. It is important that you contribute through regular envelope offerings: don't assume that someone else will pay for the ministry you expect.

Renovation Project

Phase 1 is complete! Total Cost: \$249,314

Phase 2 is set to begin! It will involve renovations, alterations, and restoration of the interior. A detailed plan will be presented in the near future. Keep your contributions coming and we will see major improvements to the interior of our church.
