Keeping a Holy Lent: What is the Season of Lent?

Lent is a season of preparation leading up to Easter. It is the forty days plus the six Sundays before Easter. (Sundays are celebrations of Jesus resurrection) For centuries, it has been observed as a special time of self examination and penitence. Lent is a time for concentration on fundamental values and priorities, and is not a time for self punishment. Throughout Lent, the worship services of the church take on a simpler tone, appropriate to this season. Banners are removed from the church. Crosses showing the risen Christ are veiled. The word Alleluia is not used in the words of the liturgy or hymns. These practices help the worshipping community to mark this season of renewal as a special time in the church year.

The custom is to mark the season of Lent by giving up some things and taking on others: we see it as a holy time of preparation. Lent is also an especially appropriate time for the sacrament of confession. While confession to a priest is not required to receive God's forgiveness, it can be a meaningful rite of reconciliation to God.

We also mark the season by attending midweek Lenten services beginning with our Ash Wednesday service on Feb 22nd at 7pm. We invite you to make these services part of your journey.

During our Sunday morning services throughout Lent we will be using a series entitled 'By My Hand: For My Sake'. Look at your hands: amazing things – two palms, ten digits, capable of working in harmony and two thumbs capable of wielding a mighty hammer or a tiny tweezer: your hands have been marvelously engineered by God. The question is why?
