Rector's Report:

2011 was a successful year for our parish. Your contributions enabled us to complete Phase 1 of our Church Renovation Project, to maintain our parish hall and to offer opportunities for those who desire to be formed and shaped in the image and likeness of Christ. Some of the highlights of the past year include a SEMINAR on Liturgical Planning; Bible Studies; a Marriage preparation course; baptismal preparation classes; a Seder meal; a Lenten Retreat and a prayer walk; confirmation classes; Sunday School, VBS and CLB. We continue to offer three worship services every week and we have recently included an evening study to our schedule: entitled God's Story your story. These sessions are taking the place of our fellowship services: many thanks to those who were faithful to our fellowships but there is a time and a season for everything under heaven. Our 7pm Sunday Services have moved to our parish hall: but we will continue to offer our evening prayer from both BCP AND BAS along with our prayer and praise and our gospel hymn sings. This summer we will offer an evening service every Wednesday at 7:00pm.

We will not be hiring a visitation minister for 2012 instead your clergy have taken on specific primary roles: Robin will focus primarily on Visitation; Sam will focus primarily on follow-up and I will focus primarily on administration. This does not mean that we will be limited to these roles.

I remind you that ministry involves every baptized person and not just the ordained. Godly Play: I have one person willing to be trained as a Godly Play Storyteller for our Sunday School and I need at least one other person. Our goal is to send a minimum of two individuals to a Seminar in May to be trained in this style of ministry for children.

Hospitality Team: Do you know the people/ person in the pew next to you? I am looking for a small group to plan two fun days each year, and a "Tea Time" each month after one of our 10 am services. The goal is to get to know one another. If hospitality is your gift, I would love to hear from you.

Stewardship: Do you want your Church to grow? Growth comes by moving forward not by staying where we are. I challenge you to increase your offering to the church by 1% this year: this increase would include your volunteer time and talent as well as your envelope offerings to All Saints.

I will be revitalizing our Stewardship committee this year and Rev Everett has agreed to be part of this ministry team. I am asking you to give prayerful thought to joining us. Please give me a call if you are willing to serve in this area of ministry.

Bequest: We were blessed this week to receive a bequest from one of our parishioners whose desire to support the work of this church was included in her Last Will and Testament.
