Approximately 20 years ago, Mr. Leslie Petten presented our congregation with information on The Anglican Communion Flag: he had hoped that our parish would one day fly this flag as a symbol of our membership within the Anglican Communion.

The emblem of the Anglican Communion, the Compass Rose, was designed by the Reverend Canon Edward N. West in 1954.

At the center is the red cross of St. George on a shield, a reminder of the origins of the Anglican Communion and a unifying link of the past within the communion today. Encircling the cross is a band bearing the inscription "The Truth shall make you free" in the original New Testament Greek. From the band radiate the points of the compass symbolizing the worldwide spread of the Anglican faith. Surmounting the shield, at the north, is a mitre, the symbol of the Apostolic Order which is essential to all the churches which constitute the Anglican Communion.

Today the Compass Rose is used throughout the Anglican Communion as a symbol of the Anglican family of churches.

The design was adapted with the colors of blue and gold and made into a flag by Canadian-born priest, Father Andrew Notere and presented to The Archbishop of Canterbury in December 1990. The flag was officially inaugurated at the Meeting of the Primates of the Communion in Belfast in April 1991.

On Wednesday, April 25th from his bed at the Caribou Memorial Veteran's Pavilion in St. John's, Mr. Petten presented us with an official flag of the Anglican Communion.

We will fly it with pride !
