Estimated cost of Phase 2: interior renovations: \$500,000

We anticipate completing this second phase in three stages beginning with the north wing and the chancel: this stage will involve new electrical, insulation of exterior walls, addition of wheelchair accessible washroom, a new vestry, upgrades to the chancel, new windows on the east wall as well as the refurbishing of our stained glass windows.
