Attention Knitters!!!

Anyone interested in knitting a prayer shawl is ask to have it in by the last Sunday in October.

Prayer Shawl Pattern

The shawls takes a large ball of red heart wool on size 7 needles. Approximate dimensions are 22x60 inches.

Cast on 63 stitches or some multiple of 3. Row 1: knit 3, purl 3, repeat across row. Row 2: knit the purl and the purl the knits.

The group of 3 stitches represents the trinity and as we knit we pray.

Count the number of 3 stitch repeats you have and add one for the other. Fringe can be any length. For fringe approx. 6 inches long, cut three 12 inch pieces of yarn for each fringe cluster, for both ends. Insert crochet hook in spaces between k3/p3, fold fringe in half, hook fold through end of shawl, tuck ends through the loop and pull up to tighten.
