Today we celebrate Canada's birthday but we must never forget that, on this day in history, 801 men from the 1st Newfoundland Regiment faced German forces in The Battle of Beaumont Hamel: the next day, only 68 remained to answer the roll call, the rest were killed, wounded or missing in action.
The battle of Beaumont Hamel was fought on the opening day of the Battle of the Somme July 1, 1916, and is remembered as one of the darkest days in Newfoundland history.
