## Renovation update: Work starts up again this week!!

With the construction boom comes a shortage of workers for our contractors but thankfully an electrician will be on site this coming week to begin wiring. Once the wiring is complete on the North side and in the Chancel, everything else will move along rather quickly.

As of June 30<sup>th</sup> our church renovation fund totals \$131,108.99 and we anticipate that the work on the north side, the vestry and the chancel will cost us \$150,000 which means a shortfall of \$18,891 in funds needed to cover cost of this portion of our project. Once this is complete we will begin the next step which will include the south wall, the choir room and the chapel. Your funds are essential: consider what you are able to donate and make that contribution today.
