Don't Miss Lynda's Return Visit to St. John's – Sept. 19th – Arts and Culture Centre

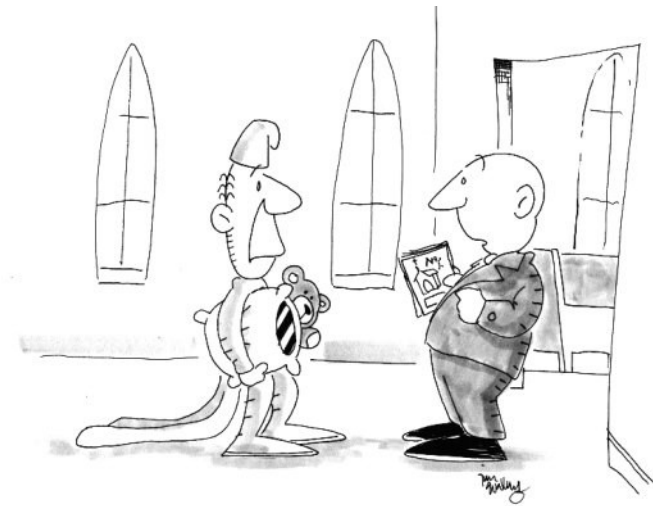
