SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT DURING ADVENT

The season of advent is a gift and like any gift it isn't useful unless you open it!! Scripture reminds us that we need to be still and know. Take a few minutes every morning to sit with God, who said "ask and you shall receive, seek and you will find, knock and it shall be opened to you". Speak to him. One pattern that is helpful when praying is the vision of the cross. As you focus on the top simply tell God how much you love him, then move to the left transept and confess your sins, turn to the right transept and give thanks, move to the center of the cross and pray for others, and finally move to the foot of the cross where you lay down your own needs before Jesus.

Don't forget to study...St Paul said, "have this mind in you which is in Christ Jesus". Get to know Jesus in the Gospel narratives and finally as you move from your quiet space to begin your day, remember to rejoice and be glad because God walks with you.
