The Epiphany of our Lord

Epiphany of our Lord is an important and ancient Christian holy day.

Since ancient times, the day of the Epiphany has been celebrated on January 6th. The season of Epiphany is from January 6th until the day before Ash Wednesday (the first day of Lent).

The word "Epiphany" means "to shine upon, to reveal, or to appear, manifest".

The Epiphany celebrates God's revealing or manifesting of Jesus' identity as true God, Messiah, and Savior of the world. God did not demand that we discover on our own who Jesus of Nazareth is. God took the initiative by his grace and revealed Jesus as eternal God as well as man.

Remembering the Epiphany reminds us that God has come looking for us through his word and sacraments. Through these he has revealed his son to us personally, so that through faith we know Jesus to be the mighty God, the Savior of the world; and we believe him to be our God and our Savior.
