We Honor Our Past and Invest in Our Future

As we move around the community the pride is evident in the smiles and comments of the elderly who love their church. They are so grateful that we've honored their work by restoring and renovating the house that holds our Church. This building was built, not in a time of plenty, but during the great depression: a labour of love.

The labour of love continues. Work on the East Wall and North Wing is nearly complete, thanks to your support. The remainder of work in the chancel (altar area) will be completed as we move forward. The old vestry has been stripped out and with new insulation, wiring, gyproc etc this room will make a beautiful new choir room. The washroom will soon be ready for use. Over the coming weeks, work will progress on the South wing: this will include our new chapel. We will also be working on the ceiling over the center aisle. The final stage will include the porch, entrance, balcony, chancel and flooring. All of this will take money.

It is vital that we continue making contributions towards this project. Our goal is to get this completed this year with all bills paid. This is a goal that we can achieve as we remain focused, united and intentional.

There are still some lights available for purchase as memorials: for a \$100.00 donation you might want to consider putting a wall sconce in memory of a loved one; for \$200.00 you can do the same with the small hanging lights in both wings or for \$300.00 you may donate a large hanging light in the chancel, or center aisle area.

The doors to the vestry, choir room and hallway to bathroom, may be given in memory for a donation of \$1500.00 for each door.
