PRAYER

Do you know that it is never too late to pray? Did anyone ever tell you that you can start to pray at any time in your life's journey? We do not need to be concerned with time-frames or schedules. For example: Lent began on Ash Wednesday and if, by chance, you forgot to begin to pray or if you did not think about adding more prayers to your daily life - all is not lost! You can begin right now - TODAY! YEAH...Isn't this wonderful news??

Our GOD is a loving father who only wants what is good for His children. There is only one condition. We have to invite God into our lives. We must include GOD into our daily activities. Because Adam and Eve disobeyed God in the Garden of Eden, God gave us 'free-will' and God will stand outside the door of our hearts until we ask Him to enter. If God is not invited, He will not force His way in. Are you afraid to invite God in? It can be frightening; no doubt about it. Do you remember what your earthly parent's taught you about fear? We learned from an early age that the best way to handle our fears is to face them head on. We were taught to look fear straight into the eye and stand up for yourself. And what would happen then? That fear diminished. It became smaller and more manageable. Fear makes you stand still; leaving you unable to move forward.

All Saint's would like to help you with your fears by offering support to you in the form of 'assisted prayers'. We have a Spiritual Development committee, an Anglican Fellowship of Prayer representative and Clergy who are willing to meet and pray with you about your fears, your needs, and your concerns. There will be an opportunity to avail of these services after the Sunday evening prayer sessions on March 10 and March 17.
