PRAYER How many of you have had to listen to someone who tests your faith when they say that attending church services is not an important part of being a Christian? Many times, I feel that my faith as been tested by this opposition to church-going. After listening to many points of view and after much thought, I have decided that attending Church is one of the most important steps on our spiritual journey.

Remember the story about the old Cherokee and his grandson? The older one told the younger one that there are 2 wolves inside each of us waging a war – the good one and the bad one.
