Vacation Bible School

In the summer of 1980, the Eastern Diocese sent its Programme Officer to six parishes to organize and lead a week-long Vacation Bible School in each. Among the parishes which took part in this programme was All Saints, CBS. Where there were 8 to 10 leaders and about 80 children.

The surprising thing is that every summer since 1980- that's 33 years- there's been a Vacation Bible School at All Saints. Some have been led by clergy, others by lay leaders, but all have been well attended, with up to 106 last year(2012). All have also been supported by members of the congregation who have provided and served snacks, responded to requests for materials, given donations of money and given their time as needed.

But do we stop and look at this piece of work? For five days the children are given lessons in pictures, in songs, in stories, in craft activities and in games. These events take about 3 hours, making 15 hours a week, plus plus participation in the following Sunday service. The format of the programme is such that children find it enjoyable.

It appears that many of the children of church-going families do attend VBS, and probably become leaders. But many who come along are children whose families do not attend church and who have only the day-school Bible story teaching.

How important then, is V.B.S. to them? For the ages 3 to 12 this week is their only contact with the church in a special teaching event. Other then Jesus' birthday party at Christmas, V.B.S. might be their only contact with the church for the year.

Not only is this a great occasion for the children, it is also an opportunity for every member of the congregation to carry out a promise made when we attended a Baptism. Do you remember when we promise that we will this child in his/her life in Christ? And maybe we wondered how we would do that. Supporting V.B.S. is one way.

Do you have time to give? Do you have talent to share? Do you have money to share?
