Waiting has never been my strong suit but it's what I have to do. While I wait I am aware of my vulnerability: not good at that either. Isn't it interesting when you come to a place where you have absolutely no control over what's happening to you.

So here I am, waiting, vulnerable and very aware of God. I give thanks that while I am weak, He is strong and I smile because God is the one who is and always will be in control: so I give it over to Him.

In the stillness, I listen and I wait at the feet of Jesus: I can't think of a better place to be, can you?

I know that it is God who arms me with strength and keeps my way secure. He makes my feet like the feet of a deer; he causes me to stand on the heights. He trains my hands for battle; my arms can bend a bow of bronze. Psalm 18: 32-34
