#### Hope for Baby Watoto

There are many vulnerable babies in Uganda who are abandoned or orphaned due to poverty, lack of education and the HIV/AIDS crisis. Almost all of them fail to make it to their 5th birthday because of the much-needed intense care and medical attention that their immediate relatives cannot provide.

Baby Watoto provides care to destitute babies aged 0-2 years, giving them the best possible start in life. When they are older and physically well enough, they either graduate to a Watoto children's village or are reunited with existing relatives.

Watoto has rescued over 300 babies: they are the lucky ones. So many others need rescuing. Once they come into a Baby Watoto home, they are given the same love and care that all babies need.

Jesus loves these precious babies and is entrusting His Church (us) with the opportunity to help them. In Matthew 25:31-46 we hear Jesus say: 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.'

All Saints' is responding to Jesus desire to provide for these babies by hosting a Christmas Party on December 1<sup>st</sup> the first of Advent. Our 10am service that day will focus on bringing hope to Uganda. Following our service we invite you to join us at the parish hall for a little party in honor of Baby Watoto. There is a possibility that a young man from Uganda will be joining us that day !!

We ask that you consider the babies when you do your shopping for Christmas. Buy one less gift this year and give the money you would have spent on that gift to them. Our donation will be used for sleepers, diapers, formula, medicine and toys for the little ones.

Let's bring Christmas to these precious children!
