A Note from the Anglican Chaplaincy, Eastern Health A reminder for persons entering the St. John's Hospitals and who would like to see a chaplain during your stay to make sure you or a family member tells the admitting clerk 'I would like to see the chaplain during my time in hospital'. You will then be asked your religious affiliation and will receive a visit from the chaplain within a day or two.

Visitation is important to us and to you: Unfortunately sometimes we are unaware of your situation : if you would like a home visit from your clergy, please let us know. You may call the office, leave your name and telephone number and we will get back to you to arrange a convenient time.

Beyond the Altar Rail: If you are going through a **short-term illness** which prevents you from attending our regularly scheduled Sunday services, we would be happy to bring communion to your home from the altar rail on Sunday morning. You will need to contact the office by Thursday prior to the service with your request and we will arrange to have one of our Eucharistic Assistants come to your home.
