Rector's Corner

Forest Gump is one of my all time favourite movies. In it he compares life to a box of chocolates: you never know what you will get. Life is filled with surprises: some will challenge you to the core. The question I am often asked is how do I hold onto my faith. I hold fast to God's Word. I may not understand it all, but it gives me peace. Paul reminds me that faith is being sure of what I hope for and certain of what I do not see. (Heb 11:1). In his second letter to the Corinthians he writes that outwardly we will suffer, wear and tear but inwardly we receive fresh strength. The little troubles we face are transitory, they are winning for us a permanent, glorious and solid reward out of all proportion to our gain. Look, not on what can be seen but look to the invisible which is eternal. (2 Cor 4:16-18) If you are being challenged to hold unto your faith, know that God understands. You and I belong to the God of the mountain and the God of the valley, in our weakness He remains strong.
