At an early age I was taught to kneel in prayer before God when I went to Church, it was a sign of reverence. In fact the idea of kneeling is biblically based beginning with Moses and the Israelites, King David and Daniel. People including: the wise men ( Mt 2:11), the leper ( Lk 5:12), the Syrophenician woman, the father of the epileptic boy( Mt17:14), the mother of the Sons of Zebedee ( Mt 20:20) Simon Peter ( Lk 5:8), and Mary the sister of Lazarus ( Jn 11: 32), have bowed and knelt down in the presence of Jesus. Kneeling or bowing aren't compulsory acts but they are outward signs of our reverence for God and aid our hearts in reverence. “Come let us worship and bow down. Let us kneel before the Lord our God, our Maker.” ( Ps 95:6)

## HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL SERVICE.

We hope you will join the Jewish Community Havura for its annual Holocaust Memorial Service on Sunday, April 12th at 7:30 p.m. This year’s theme is *War-time Experiences of a Jewish Child*. Our guest speaker will be Lisa Hurd, a Holocaust survivor, local actress and long-time resident of St. John’s. Lisa and her parents escaped from Vienna in 1939. She came to Newfoundland from England in 1968 with her husband and four children. She will share some of her early life story, which until now only her family and closest friends knew. The service will be held at the Bruneau Centre for Research and Innovation auditorium on the Memorial University campus. Free parking in lot 18 behind the Queen Elizabeth II Library off Prince Philip Drive, and lot 15 B next to the School of Music. \$2.00 parking available in lot 17 in front of the Bruneau Centre. The service is co-sponsored by the Atlantic Jewish Council and the Scholarship in the Arts Programme, Department of History, Memorial University of Newfoundland.
