HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL SERVICE.

We hope you will join the Jewish Community Havura for its annual Holocaust Memorial Service on Sunday, April 12th at 7:30 p.m. This year's theme is *Wartime Experiences of a Jewish Child*. Our guest speaker will be Lisa Hurd, a Holocaust survivor, local actress and long-time resident of St. John's. Lisa and her parents escaped from Vienna in 1939. She came to Newfoundland from England in 1968 with her husband and four children. She will share some of her early life story, which until now only her family and closest friends knew. The service will be held at the Bruneau Centre for Research and Innovation auditorium on the Memorial University campus.
