**Refugee Situation** In the letter we received from our Bishop in September, he had asked us if our parish would help out with the Syrian Refugees along with other parishes. At the following vestry meeting, it was discussed and agreed that we couldn't afford to sponsor a family on our own, but would help with another parish.. It was agreed that the five parishes of Portugal Cove, Paradise, St. Philips, New Hope and All Saints would come together and sponsor a family. The clergy of the five parishes have met and a committee has been put into place with people from each parish. The committee had their first meeting and each of the members have selected areas of responsibility ; we will be responsible for finding a doctor, dentist, and eye specialist if needed.

All Saints and the parish of New Hope has agreed to work together to raise \$6800.00 as our portion of the sponsorship.
