### Rector's Remarks

Good Morning, and in particular, welcome to our Guiders this morning.

Today, we are pleased to be hosting the Guiding Movement in our worship service which is part of their Thinking Day celebrations. This service is held on the Sunday closest to the birthdays of Lord and Lady Baden-Powell, February 22<sup>nd</sup>.

As a parish, we offer our hospitality to the Guiders by providing them access to our Parish Hall every Wednesday evening, for Leader Meetings as they take place throughout the year and for an occasional sleepovers on weekends. We offer this hospitality for the simple reason that we, as a parish, want to support the ministry and work with our youth and that we believe in the quality of their program.

The Guiding Movement, originally begun in South Africa, has now spread to 146 countries around the world. We are pleased that we have such an active organization hosted by All Saints.

Each year on February 22, Member Organizations of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) celebrate World Thinking Day. World Thinking Day is a special day to reflect on our global sisterhood in Guiding and to think about issues that are important to girls and women around the world. This year's World Thinking Day theme is 'Grow' – inspiring Girl Guide and Girl Scout members around the world to encourage more girls and young women to experience what it means to be part of the Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting Movement. Since 1999, the original concept of a Thinking Day service has gone global. It also involved various projects, some fund raising, some to help our planet. This year, Guiders are encouraged to plant trees.

As a note of encouragement I quote from Lady Baden-Powell,

***“Though you cannot visit sister Guides in France or Finland, in Austria or Australia, in Italy or Iceland, Canada or Chile, Ghana or Guatemala, U.S.A. or U.A.R., you can reach out to them there in your MIND. And in this unseen, spiritual way you can give them your uplifting sympathy and friendship. Thus do we Guides, of all kinds and of all ages and of all nations, go with the highest and the best towards the spreading of true peace and goodwill on earth.”***
