

Due to the restrictions placed upon us by COVID-19 regulations, our Blue Christmas Service, which is scheduled for **December 13th at 7:00pm**, will be modified slightly this year. There will be only one symbolic candle lit on behalf of all those who have passed. The deadline to register is December 10th at noon. You are reminded that we have a limited capacity of 100 people.

**CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS EVE PAGEANT -** Regretfully, due to COVID-19 restrictions, we are unable to host a children's pageant this Christmas Eve. However, we will be pre-recording the Children's Christmas

Eve Pageant, and this will be available on our parish website, <u>allsaintsparish.ca</u> for all of our children to watch as often as they wish during the Christmas period.

CHRISTMAS FOOD HAMPERS - Last year the CBS/Paradise Food Bank distributed over 437 Christmas hampers. Due to the COVID-19 situation, many avenues of support for the Annual Christmas Hamper Appeal may not be available this year. The Food Bank will be relying upon financial donations to ensure families and individuals in need receive a hamper during this coming Christmas season. A hamper for one person costs \$50, for two-three people \$75, and for a family of four or more the cost is



\$100. If you are unable to donate the cost of a full hamper, any donation is appreciated, and we thank you very much.

To request a Christmas Hamper in the CBS/Paradise area, please contact the CBS/Paradise Food Bank at 834-2800 by December 4th. Distribution is December 15th - 18th, from 9:00am - 2:00pm. Our last day at the Food Bank for 2020 is December 19th, and we will reopen again on January 5th, 2021.

## INFLUENZA VACCINE CLINIC

We next Eastern Health's Influenza Vaccine Clinic is scheduled for December 22nd from 10:00am to 7:00pm. These Clinics follow the Public Health Agency of Canada Guidelines which can be <u>found here</u>.

Appointments will be pre booked via <a href="www.timefortheshot.ca">www.timefortheshot.ca</a> or by calling 1-833-951-3904. Clients should arrive 5 mins before their appointments, check in with security and have COVID screening completed before entering the building. Clients and staff will have to wear a face mask at all times, and if they do not have one they will be provided with one. Clients will be registered and sent to the appropriate vaccination station, then directed to their cars after the immunization has been completed. Nurses will disinfect the chairs and tables in between clients, and high touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day.

**WELCOME BACK TO OUR IN-CHURCH WORSHIP -** We would like to remind you that Pre-Registration is a Provincial and Diocesan requirement, and we would like to thank you for your continued cooperation. Each week we will alternate between using the BCP and the BAS as we celebrate the Holy Eucharist.
