On the main floor there was a funeral reception – more people preparing to serve a cup of tea to those who had just laid a loved one to rest. Both levels of the Church's parking lot are filled. The hands and feet of Jesus were at work in our Parish during these two outreach events, helping people, bringing people together, reminding them of God's great love for them.

The big picture in all of this is the presence of God working in our lives. As we prepare for Christmas, we are reminded that God is continually sending us into the world to continue and fulfill the work that Jesus began, to continue His mission. *We are the hands and feet of Jesus*.

A TRIBUTE TO DAVE BUTLER



On March 9th, 2022 our family suffered a tremendous loss. Dave's passing created a gap in our lives that can never be replaced. Dave was a devoted husband, dad, pop, brother, brother-in- law, uncle and friend to all. The significant impact that he made on the lives of others was immense. He touched the lives of everyone he met with his welcoming smile and loving words. Dave cherished his family, wife, kids, grandkids and all children as his own. He was so proud of the accomplishments of others. Dave had a way of making everyone feel valued and important.

He loved the great outdoors, walking, camping, trouting, ATVing, skidooing, boil ups, campfires, having a yarn and a game of cards. Dave was always there with a helping hand. He was involved in the community at a young age, joining the Orange Young Bretons, CLB and later the CLB Old Comrades. When he retired from NL Hydro he switched gears to volunteering, which was very rewarding. He started driving cancer patients to and from hospital for treatments. For years, Dave and his wife Barbara often waited for those patients. The care and support those individuals received was immeasurable.

Dave also volunteered with All Saints Parish. He helped with the huge renovation of the church, he greeted the congregation with his welcoming smile as they walked in the Church, he was a sides person, on the Cemetery Committee and spent countless hours providing support when needed.

In later years he volunteered with the CLB Food Bank, which he did for years right up to his passing. Dave was also lead hand in building the CLB Old Comrades hut, which he truly enjoyed doing. Since his passing the hut has been renamed in his memory, "Camp Dave Butler," showing his dedication to the project. Dave was named "Citizen of the Year" in 2011 which is an honor he truly earned. Over the years he had health issues but he seemed to take it all in stride. He left us all so quickly, his thoughts unknown, no time to say goodbye and only God knows why.
