

Set Sail



CHARTING THE COURSE FOR CHRIST'S CHURCH

STRATEGIC PLAN: DIOCESE OF ENL – The Diocese is embarking on a three-year strategic plan titled, ‘*Set Sail: Charting the Course for Christ’s Church*’. There are four phases (focus areas) in this plan: Deepening Relationships, Transforming Discipleship, Renewing Stewardship, and Engaging Partnerships.

We are delighted to say that All Saints CBS has already undertaken advancement in several of those areas. As the Diocese works towards these goals together, they will be looking for ways to share the stories of how we are living out the goals.

The Bishop has made the following request:

To help lay the foundation for measuring our progress, we would like to understand the current views of the people of the Diocese on personal faith and parish life. We will use these views as a baseline against which we will measure the impact of Set Sail. Participation is completely anonymous, and there is no direct link between the responses and people or parishes. No personal information is being collected. We would love to hear from you and the people around you! The survey can be completed on your smartphone, tablet/iPad, or computer. A **'Rule of Life'** is a decision to live your life under God in intentional ways. It is a covenant with God to undertake this task with His grace for a set time, say six months. At the end of this period you can review it and renew the covenant, using the same Rule, or reducing it if it has been too demanding, or enlarging it if it has gone well. It is wise to start simple. In the long run, if you continue to use a Rule, do it for a year and review it annually.

The Rule helps to give direction to your life and to ensure balance so that it includes the whole person. It also forms you as a Christian. Here are some suggestions about what you can include:


- Worship and prayer
- Bible and spiritual reading
- Ministry/service re the parish, workplace, community, and the use of your skills/gifts
- Physical well-being re exercise, diet, and leisure
- Using your intellect re reading, radio, television, online, courses
- Witnessing to your faith
- Social justices' issues
- Relationships re family, friend, others
- Morality and ethics re values, temptations, integrity
- Others - annual retreat, stewardship, care of environment, solitude, community, fasting, spiritual direction, soul friend.
- An important part of the Rule is an Examen. It is a daily reflection at the end of each day on what went on in your life.

Here is an example of how to make a Rule:

1. I will worship at least once a Sunday.
2. I will pray daily (at a set time or times).
3. I will read the Bible daily.
4. I will do spiritual reading daily.
5. I will examine my life daily or weekly.
6. I will service in the parish as . . .
7. I will volunteer in the community as . . .
8. I will exercise _____ minutes daily, 5 days a week.
9. I will make Sunday a day of rest.
10. I will engage in one creative activity.
11. I will reduce my food consumption when necessary.
12. I will read one hour a day. I will read one book a month.
13. I will witness to Jesus Christ by acting as Jesus, seeing him in others . . .
14. I will support at least one initiative re social justice issues.
15. I will keep regular contact with family and friends.
16. I will examine my moral values in light of God's purpose and will, and act out of them
17. I will protect the environment. I will recycle.
18. I will look after my property and possessions.
19. I will make an annual budget.
20. I will give ___% of my income to Church and charities.
21. I will make a will.
