7:00 PM WEDNESDAY EVENING LENTEN SERVICES – We will be holding our traditional **7:00pm Wednesday evening Lenten services** each week, running through until March 29th. All are welcome.

THURSDAY MORNING LENTEN EUCHARIST - Rev Hobbs will be holding Holy Eucharist services each **Thursday morning at 10:00am in the Chapel**, starting March 2nd and running through until March 30th. All are welcome.

LENTEN BIBLE STUDY – We are offering a seven-week bible study on **Tuesday mornings at 10:00am**. We will be using ***The Way of God: A guide to following Jesus*** by Scott Gunn and will also be looking at a number of spiritual practices.

QUIET DAY - On **Saturday, March 18**, the church will be open from **9:30am-3:00pm** as a silent space. You are invited to come for the whole time or drop in for a spell. The day begins **10:00am** with Morning Prayer. At **11:00am** a reading from Pilgrim's Progress by John Bunyan. Mid-day prayer is at **Noon**, followed by lunch. At **1:00pm** a reading from Pilgrim's Progress, and again at **2:00pm**. The day will end at **2:30pm** with Holy Eucharist. You can use the silent time for prayer, reading (you can bring a book), meditation, or just be silent. Or you can treat the space as a desert, joining Jesus in his temptation, bringing your own struggles and temptations.
