ALL SAINTS' COMMUNITY FOOD BANK - March has been designated National Nutrition Month, and this year the theme is to bring greater awareness to the practice of healthy eating habits. In the past, many of us will recall this month being referred to as 'the long hungry month of March'. Unfortunately, hunger is still a serious problem for many in our community - not knowing where their next meal is coming from, and children often going to school hungry. With the increase in the cost of living, more people than ever are going to food banks. During this Lenten season as we reflect with gratitude on our many blessings, it is a good time to display kindness by giving to those in need. One way we can make a difference is by supporting the All Saints Food Bank with regular contributions of non-perishable food items or a monetary offering. Jesus said, *"As you do unto the least of these my brethren, you do unto me."*

VOAR RELOCATION CELEBRATION CONTEST - Lighthouse FM is moving to a new location, and we need to raise \$500,000 to fully remodel, our new studios.
