ANNIVERSARY OF OPENING OF OUR PARISH HALL – Thursday of this past week was

the 42rd anniversary of the opening of our Parish Hall. Kudos to Archdeacon Owen Coffin and all those who had the vision back then to move forward with that project. Our Parish Hall is now a landmark in Conception Bay South, and is used for many of our outreach projects, including each Wednesday



for our very popular "All Saints Tea Room" which draws some 120 people each week.

RESTRICTIONS LIFTED ON COMMON CUP AND CONSECRATED WATER OF BAPTISM

Effective May 28, 2023, the Bishop has given permission for the return of the shared chalice at the Holy Eucharist, <u>and</u> the sharing of the baptismal water among candidates within the liturgy of Holy Baptism. This is <u>only for those who wish to receive</u>, and it does not mean that anyone who is uncomfortable with receiving the chalice must receive it - it is <u>entirely left to the person's own discretion</u>. The practice of intinction (dipping the host into the wine) is <u>not permitted</u>. Also, the sharing of consecrated water from the font among multiple baptismal candidates is now permitted, with the priest wearing a mask and sanitizing their hands between candidates. If a parent is uncomfortable, they may ask for separate consecrated water. Once again, <u>nobody should feel uncomfortable asking to be excluded</u> from this open practice.
