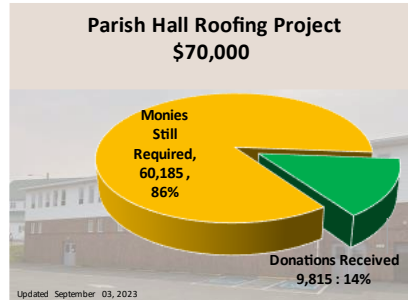

Vestry, after having secured several quotations, have awarded the project to Turner Enterprises, who will cover the existing shingles with metal roofing.
