

shingles that have blown off the roof as a result of a number of high wind- storms, and consequently we have recently developed a number of leaks in our Parish Hall. Vestry have secured several quotations, and have awarded the project to Turner Enterprises, who will cover the existing shingles with metal roofing. At this time, we are asking Parishioners and




