REVIVE PROGRAM STARTING JANUARY 21ST

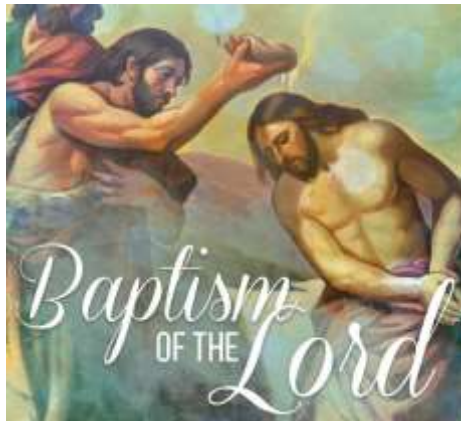
