and we will reserve one for you, and you can then

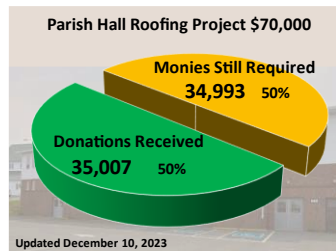
forward your donation to donations@allsaintsparish.ca,
