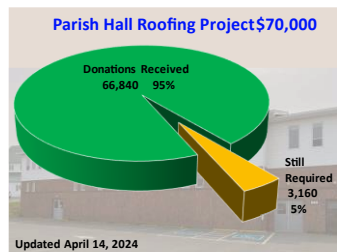

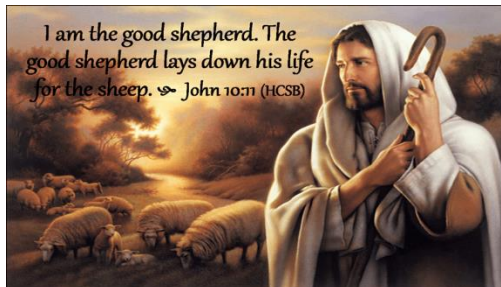
4501. Our **All Saints Prayer Chain Group** is a very active ministry which has a large number of prayerful members ready to reach out in thoughtful prayer.
