

INTERACTIVE INFORMATION SESSION WITH SISTER ELIZABETH DAVIS

All Saints Anglican Parish CBS will be hosting an interactive information session with Sister Elizabeth Davis on Monday evening, May 27th, starting at 7:00pm in our Church. Sister Elizabeth Davis is one of 54 women delegates to the Catholic Synod on Synodality, with

month-long sessions in Rome in October 2023, and again in October 2024.

This marks the first Synod of Bishops at which women are present and included as voting members.

Sister Elizabeth will share with us:

- Her experience in Rome,
- The fruits of the session in October 2023
- Her experience of meetings with diverse groups since that event,
- And her expectations of the event at the second session in October 2024.

Sister Elizabeth will also seek wisdom from the participants on ways of creating an inclusive church which works with other churches and faith traditions to shape a more just and peaceful world - a key theme of living a synodal Church in mission.

THY KINGDOM COME is a global ecumenical prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray, from Ascension to Pentecost, for more people to come to know Jesus.
