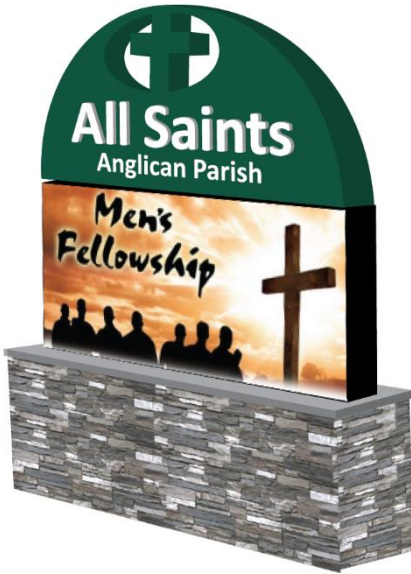
- Our **secure drop-slot**, located to the left of the Parish Hall main door, which is emptied daily, is available 7/24
