DIAKONIA - On this coming Tuesday several people will be ordained as Deacons in the Church, among them Bill Haynes. The first Deacons were the seven in the New Testament, including Stephen, the first Christian martyr. While Deacons are one of the Orders of the three-fold ordained ministry, it can also be a role of every Christian. The Greek word 'diakonia" has to do with care and service (1 Corinthians 12.5/ Ephesians 4.14). The most famous ikon of the Orthodox Church is the one depicting the Holy Trinity by Andrei Reuben. It can be interpreted in various ways. It is based on the story of Abraham welcoming the three visitors, who in the ikon are presented as God the Holy Trinity. It teaches us about the relationship within the Trinity of the Three Persons, and about our relationship to each other. First, we are to welcome the stranger as did Abraham and Sarah, especially the outcast, the marginalized and despised. Second, we are to turn to each other as the Father, Son and Holy Spirit turn to each other. This is how we create community and communion. Let us avoid ignoring or turning away from each. We are one in the Body of Christ. Every Christian is a deacon in that all are servants of Jesus Christ. This means ministering in Christ's name, especially to the poor, the sick and the helpless.


