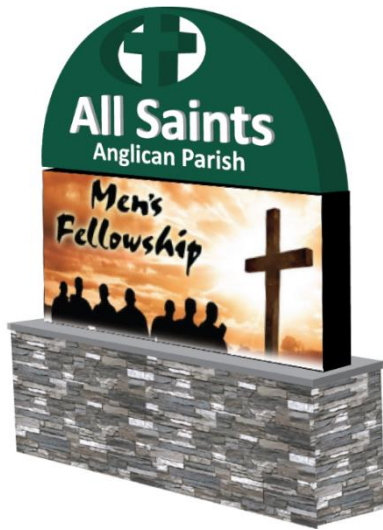

TO BEGIN THE CATHEDRAL CELEBRATIONS there will be **a said Holy Communion Service at 11:30am on June 22nd**, using the 1662 English Book of Common Prayer which would have been used in 1699 - the year the Parish was founded. This will be followed, **beginning at noon until 5:00pm, a Cathedral Heritage Fair** which celebrates 325 years as a Parish, the oldest in Canada, with music (organ, violin, cello, viola de gamba, piano, voice), quilt and rug hooking displays, sword fighting demonstration, games, stories, Shakespeare scenes, bake sale, mug and muffins. All this will be happening inside the church and outside on Gower Street where there will be a fish and chip truck. Come for an hour or for the afternoon and be sure to see our newly installed Labyrinth in the beautiful Anglican Cathedral in downtown St. John's. Free admission, donations welcomed.
