

PERPETUAL CARE FEE CHANGES – Vestry has approved the following fee changes for perpetual care grave plots, effective January 02, 2025. It is imperative that Cemetery revenues keep abreast of actual costs. A revised "Cemetery Rules and Guidelines Handbook" will be republished for distribution shortly.



- 84" length plots will increase from \$600 to \$800
- 42" length plots will increase from \$300 to \$500

RENTAL FEE INCREASE FOR LOWER LEVEL OF PARISH HALL - Vestry has approved a change in the rental fees for the Lower Level of our Parish Hall.



Effective January 01, 2025, the fee will increase from \$300 to \$400, plus a \$100 damage deposit fee, refundable after the event

if there are no issues. This applies to all rentals that do not utilize our kitchen.
