PHASE-1 OF COLUMBARIUM PROJECT - Our All Saints Cemetery Team recently

presented Vestry with a number of long-term design concepts, and our Vestry have now approved the Phase-1 process to begin with the installation of a four-side, 80-niche columbarium. The next step is for our Vestry to present the Diocese with our intent, and to seek their approval before moving forward. Please stay tuned for updates, and the date when pre-sales can begin. PERPETUAL CARE FEE CHANGES – Vestry has approved the following fee changes for perpetual care grave plots, **effective January 02, 2025**. It is imperative that Cemetery revenues keep abreast of actual costs. A revised “Cemetery Rules and Guidelines Handbook” will be republished for distribution shortly.

- 84” length plots will increase from \$600 to \$800
- 42” length plots will increase from \$300 to \$500



RENTAL FEE INCREASE FOR LOWER LEVEL OF PARISH HALL – Vestry has approved a

change in the rental fees for the Lower Level of our Parish Hall.

Effective January 01, 2025, the fee will increase from \$300 to \$400, plus a \$100 damage deposit fee, refundable after the event if there are no issues. This applies to all rentals that do not utilize our kitchen.
