abroad until the earth is full of it.

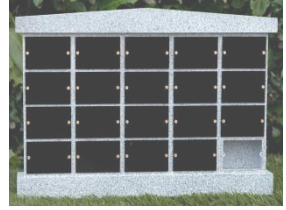
